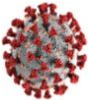

COVID UPDATE

Our 8 a.m. AND 10:30 a.m. services will be RSVP - with limited capacity up to 25. **Our 10:30 a.m. service** is also available on Zoom.

For in person worship: **Masks and hand sanitizing are required** regardless of your level of vaccination. We ask you to **physically distance** when in the company of “non-household” members. Singing is permitted with the wearing of masks. Communion will be available.

If you feel you are of a **vulnerable population** for COVID and would like to **attend in person**, you are encouraged to join us **at 8:00 a.m.** This is a spoken service, fewer people in attendance, and the first group in the building on Sunday morning. Those typically in attendance are vaccinated.

We encourage everyone to be vaccinated that are not restricted due to health issues. Some people work in high risk or front line jobs. We welcome your attendance, however ask that you cautiously adhere to our mitigation protocols.

Our mid week programs and services will be offered in-person and on zoom. Please be sure to RSVP your in-person attendance to the facilitator.
