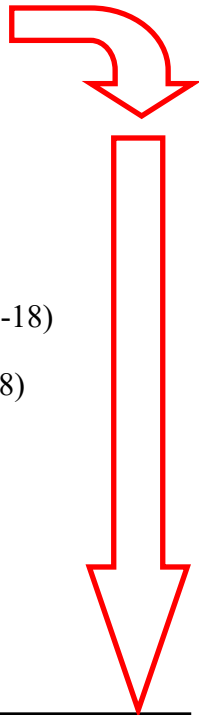

Please wear good walking shoes...It might be a little "mucky" this year. Come and wave those palm branches!

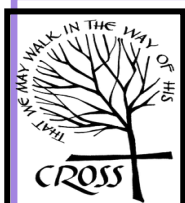

Triduum Explanations -

A period of three days of preparation for a feast day. The term is most frequently used for Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, the three days prior to Easter Sunday that are the concluding days of Holy Week, also known as the Easter Triduum. The term may indicate any three-day period of preparation for a feast. The summit of the Liturgical year is the Easter Triduum - from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

Maundy Thursday (April 2 at 7 p.m.)

Tenebrae Service—A service moving us into a period of darkness through readings and chant/sung response

Good Friday (April 3 at 7 p.m.)

Sacrament of Reconciliation—5 p.m. or by appointment
Good Friday Service and Stations of the Cross 7 p.m.

The Great Vigil of Easter (April 4th at 10:30 p.m.):

A celebration and movement from darkness to light as we bring the Light of Christ into our midst.

Easter Sunday (April 5th at 10:30 a.m.)

A celebration of the Risen Christ
Potluck and Easter egg hunt after the service
